

# What age box is suitable for my child?

Every child learns at their own pace.

Our boxes are based on the UK National Curriculum but that doesn't mean you have to purchase the year group box your child is currently in.

The easiest way to decide is to have a word with their teacher if they attend school and check if they are working below age related expectations, at age related expectations or above.

If they are home-schooled, drop us an email and we can send a maths assessment for you to do with your child to see what box is suited for them.

You can also answer the questions below.

The column that you have answered 'yes' to the most will give you advice on which box you should choose below it.

Does your child's educator have concerns with their maths?

Does your child struggle a lot with the basic concepts in their year group?

Does your child worry about maths and lacks confidence?

Is your child working below expectations?

If your child really struggles to keep up with maths at school, sign up to a previous year group so they get the basics. We can always change your year group at a later date.

Does your child struggle a bit with the basic concepts in their year group?

Can your child keep up with the class but doesn't really enjoy maths?

Is your child making good progress in maths?

Is your child working at age related expectations?

If your child is making steady progress in maths, or feels slightly behind in maths, the year group they are in is the best box option.

Does your child pick up maths concepts really quickly?

Does your child complain they are bored in their maths lessons because it is too easy?

Can your child easily solve maths problems and can articulate how they solved problems?

Is your child working above age related expectations?

If your child is making really good progress and can articulate all of their answers, perform calculations mentally and reasoning tasks and is working above age related expectations, purchase a box above their year group.
